Though he did not make boxing a career, he has many more stories and great memories. The names of Iron Mike Pusateri, Tony DeMarco and Paul Bender were ringing in my ears. He is a member of the National Veterans Boxers Association, Ring 4. Out of all the positive and negative events of war and service, Don witnessed an historical event that filled his heart with great emotion -the Prisoners of War from the ship The USS Pueblo were released and Don witnessed them walking across the Freedom Bridge at the 38th Parallel. Oh what a joyous celebration must have taken place that day!

After Don retired from the Army he changed the uniform color and went to work 11 years for the Sheriff's Department as a Corrections Officer. After trying retirement for a second time, Don found a third job working at the Boston Stock Exchange for a short time.

Meanwhile Ellie was busy with interesting careers of her own. Over the years she worked for Malden Publications and the well-known David Brickman. She also enjoyed other positions with the Malden Chamber of Commerce and City Hall. During those years a son and daughter were part of the picture so Ellie had her hands full with family, work and community activities.

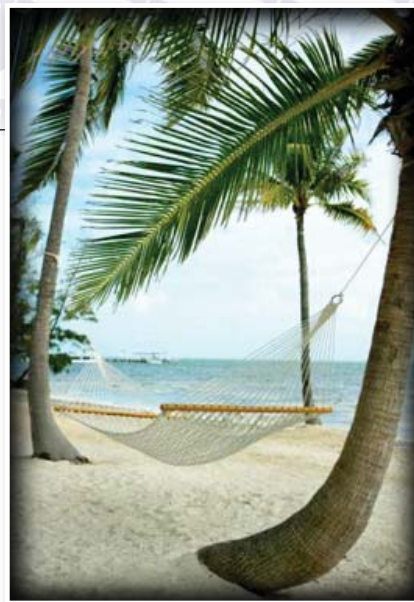

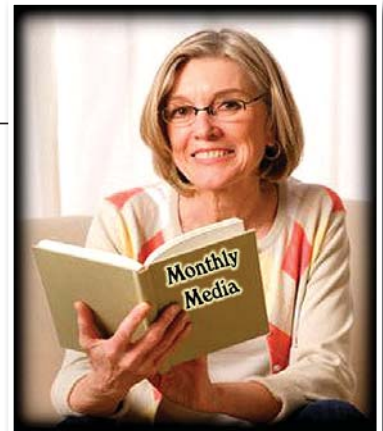

Hurricane Preparedness – What You Can Do Now



It's not too early to start getting ready in case a hurricane comes this way. You can prepare by doing the following (don't wait until a hurricane watch is issued – do this now):

Shelter: If we are ordered to evacuate – will you go to a friend's or relative's house, a hotel, or a shelter? If you have special medical needs, make sure you are registered with the Largo Fire Department or Pinellas County Emergency Management (464-3800). If you will be going to a shelter, have a folding chair, blanket, pillow, medications, special dietary needs, and books, puzzles, or games ready to go.

Important Papers: Take your insurance, banking, and other important papers with you or store them at a secure location. Include an inventory of your possessions and pictures or a videotape of them for insurance purposes. Also a back-up of your computer files.

Automobile: Keep your car's gas tank topped off during the summer (gas pumps will not work if electricity goes out).

Cash: Have a supply of cash – ATM's will not work if electricity goes out.

Medications: Fill prescriptions and remember to take your medications with you.

Home: Before you leave, store all outside furniture, potted plants, bikes, etc. in sheds or inside your home. These will become missiles if left outside. Put awnings down and secure them. Turn off your water supply and electrical breakers to prevent potential damage.

Contacts: Let friends and relatives know where you plan to stay and establish an out-of-state contact so everyone can check in after the storm.

Emergency Kit: Pack a kit with clothing, flashlight, portable radio, batteries, toiletries, hand sanitizer, trash bags, first aid items.

Food and water: Take enough water and non-perishable (remember the non-electric can opener), as well as paper towels, paper plates, and utensils to last at least a week.

Follow the advice of the Emergency Management Office provided by radio or television stations regarding evacuations. **DO NOT** stay in your mobile home.
