

hen you think of Italian people, what do you think of? I think of laughter, warmth and good food. These people have all of this and more. Both Marie and Pete grew up in East Harlem in Manhattan, New York. They came from large Italian families. Pete had 5 brothers and 3 sisters. Pete was a middle child. Marie had 3 brothers and 2 sisters and was the baby of the family.

Peter's family was a gang and if you messed

with one of them, you had all eight to contend with. They got together at Marie's Sweet Sixteen Party and it must have been a real success, as they have lasted 50 years. They

were married on February 27, 1960 and their wedding was a catered affair for 250 people. They bought their first home in East Meadows, Long Island and have lived there for 47 years.


If you ask what was their greatest achievement is, they both will tell you it is their wonderful children and grandchildren. They have two girls and a boy, and 6 grandchildren.
